- Orewa Primary School, 86 Maire Road, Orewa - Evacuation/Assembly area
- Orewa Latter Day Saints Chapel, 134 Red Beach Road, Red Beach - Evacuation/Assembly area
- Silverdale United Football Club, 6 Hibiscus Coast Highway, Silverdale - Evacuation/Assembly area

Always listen to the radio for instructions and advice on where to go. Evacuation centres / assembly areas will vary depending on the emergency.

Get ready now to protect yourself, your family, business and community

Plan to look after yourself and your loved ones for at least three days or more.

- ✓ Prepare a household emergency plan and survival kit
- ✓ Make sure you have a working radio and batteries in order to receive information
- ✓ Familiarise yourself with your local evacuation/assembly areas
- ✓ Create an **emergency phone tree** to warn and assist your neighbours

Receiving evacuation and warning information

Civil Defence warnings may be received by the following methods:

- Radio or Television
- TXT alert to your mobile phone
- Txt RDCD to 61427792934 (31c to register) or visit www.optn.co.nz (free to register)
- Warnings from other people e.g. emergency phone tree
- Emergency status updates via email or the civil defence smart phone application

Visit www.aucklandcivildefence.govt.nz to download the free app or register for email updates.

If a warning is received

- Listen to your local radio station and follow instructions and advice given
- Check your household is safe
- Check on your neighbours, advise them of the warning and assist those that need help
- Prepare to activate your household emergency plan

If you are required to evacuate

- Take your getaway kit and essential items with you
- Consider pets
- Assist those people that need help
- Follow instructions provided by your Emergency Response Group, Emergency Services and Civil Defence
- If advised to evacuate due to 'tsunami warning' move immediately on foot to high ground or as far inland as possible
- Do not return home until the 'All Clear' has been given
